AFC LLWYDCOED CLUB HISTORY

Llwydcoed Welfare AFC has been in existence since 1931 and has always been at the heart of the village community life. It was formed out of the Mining Community and has always played a full part in village life not only by encouraging and providing sporting opportunities but by organising and supporting any event through raffles jumble sales excursions. We have always seen the need to provide and support any community activity to enhance peoples lives. This approach has helped us become more successful than we could ever have imagined, So much that we are now at a stage that we have outgrown our facilities and need to upgrade them on a regular basis. The Club was formed under the welfare name as was the ground they played in the Aberdare Valley League winning the Championship on consecutive seasons 1953 and 1955. The next step was to move into the South Wales Amateur League until the 1991/1992 season. After many poor seasons the Club decided to move into the newly formed South Wales Senior League. In 1991 a new Secretary arrived with David Evans taking over. A new era arrived with the Club growing faster than you would expect and gaining Welsh League Status. At present the Club is rebuilding the Welsh League Team after relegation last season otherwise the Club has tremendous potential.
